Getting Started

1. Describe what the perfect mentor for you would be like at this season in your life? It can be any kind of mentor: professional, spiritual, social, academic, etc. What skills, experience, and characteristics would he or she have?

Digging Deeper

2. Last Sunday's sermon was about the incarnation and having a perfect example to follow in Christ. Read 1 Corinthians 4:14-17 and answer the following:

- What's the difference between "instructors" and "fathers" as Paul uses these words in v.15? In what way did Paul become a spiritual father to the Corinthians?
- What does Paul urge his readers to do as a result of him becoming their spiritual father (v.16)? Why does he command this? How do you explain this connection ("therefore")?
- What does it mean to imitate someone, in a Christian sense? Is it just mimicking outward behavior? Is it just going through the motions?
- What does Timothy have to do with all this (v.17)? How does Timothy's presence help with what Paul is writing about in vv.14-16?

3. In what ways do you feel you are more-or-less living up to the example of Christ? In what ways do you feel you may need to align more with Christ's perfect example?

4. What can Chroma do to better exemplify the love, truth, power, and beauty of Christ to our community? How can we be an example for others to follow?
